

Research Presentation

A thesis defense within one of the GSEFM Ph.D. programs requires prior completion of a module preparing for participation in the job market for research-oriented positions. For thesis defense dates from October 1, 2023 onwards this requirement may be fulfilled in one of the following two means:

- (i) Successful completion of the "job market seminar" offered once a year at GSEFM. Successful completion of this seminar is reported directly to GSEFM Academic Records by the job market seminar instructors, and this form is not needed.
- (ii) Presentation of a (possibly preliminary version of a) chapter of the dissertation at a workshop or conference. The presentation must have been given in English language by the student (not a co-author), either in a session at a scientific conference (note: poster sessions are not eligible) or in a workshop/seminar at a university (note: GSEFM seminars offered as part of the Ph.D. program curriculum are not eligible). It is expected that the presentation has been for at least twenty minutes.
