

## Guide for Using the Online Application Portal of Goethe University for MSQ/Ph.D. Program Applications

This Version: March 25, 2025

Applications for the GSEFM MSQ and Ph.D. programs must occur via the online application portal of Goethe University that is accessible at

<https://www.goethe-campus.uni-frankfurt.de/qisserver/pages/cs/sys/portal/hisinoneStartPage.faces>

(click on the language flag in the lower right-hand corner of this page to open a menu that allows you to switch to the English language version of this portal.)

Submitting an application involves working through the two parts of the portal. In the first part (subsequently **Part 1: Self-Registration**) you will be asked to provide general information that Goethe University requires to create an account on the basis of which you can subsequently log into the program application portal. Within the portal for the MSQ and Ph.D. programs you will then be asked questions specific to your MSQ/Ph.D. program application, and will also be asked to upload various documents for your application dossier (subsequently **Part 2: Program Application**).

### Note:

As explained under

in their first year at GSEFM all students enrolled in one of the Ph.D. programs at GSEFM are also automatically enrolled in the MSQ program (beyond ensuring that it is possible to earn a Master's (M.Sc.) degree along the way towards the Ph.D. degree, this is also due to university-level administrative reasons). From the second year onwards, students enrolled in one of the Ph.D. programs may de-register from the MSQ program, though it is not at all recommended to do so (in part as it irrevocably ends the option to earn a Master's degree at GSEFM). For the application portal this implies that **when applying for admission to a Ph.D. program at GSEFM, you will have to simultaneously also apply for the**

**respective track of the MSQ program** (and there is thus no option in the portal to apply for Ph.D. program admission only).

There is, however, the option to apply for admission to one of the tracks of the MSQ program only. For transition from one of the tracks of the MSQ program to the corresponding Ph.D. program, see again

In particular, MSQ Program students during their first year of studies can qualify to also be enrolled in the Ph.D. program that corresponds to their MSQ program track from the second year of studies onwards.

Implication of the above:

The program application in Part 2 for all applicants, including those who are applicants for the Ph.D. programs, begins with choosing the track of the MSQ program for which an application is made. Those who wish to apply for Ph.D. program studies in addition to MSQ program studies will need to indicate so through an option within Part 2 (the details will be explained below in that section of this user guide that refers to Part 2).

## Part 1: Self-Registration

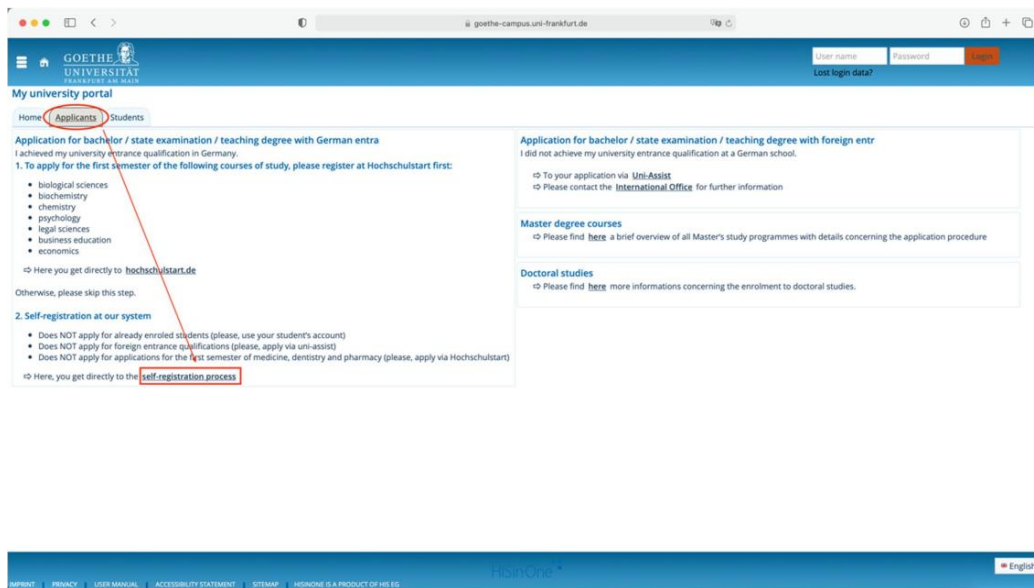
If at the time of application you are not already enrolled in a different degree program at Goethe University, you will need to start your application with the self-registration.<sup>1</sup>

Please note that while the self-registration process as documented below is strictly necessary, it is **not** necessary (and indeed not useful for applications to the GSEFM MSQ and Ph.D. programs) to enter any information through Uni-Assist (even if you obtained your university entrance qualification outside of Germany).

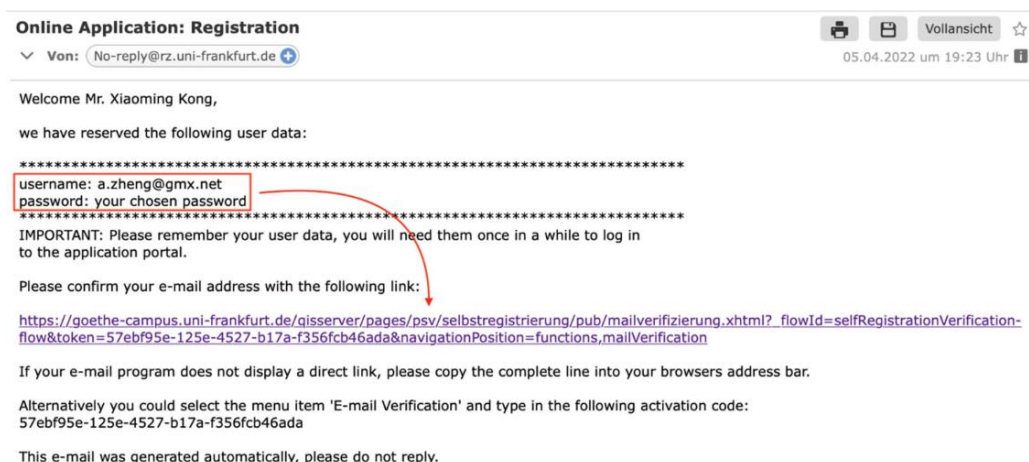

<sup>1</sup> Students who at the time of application are already enrolled in another degree program at Goethe University please directly move to Part 2.

- Note that “Data transfer from hochschulstart.de” is not a mandatory field. For those who already have an account on hochschulstart.de this field allows for a convenient way to transfer their data. However, if you do not have such an account already, we recommend to skip this field and instead complete the fields under “Personal details”.
- Please make sure that you enter an address under which you can be **permanently** reached so as to enable GSEFM to get in touch with you (should your permanent address change during the application process, make sure not to forget informing GSEFM).
- After completing the mandatory fields, you will receive an e-mail (to the address that you provided during the self-registration) with your log-in data for Part 2 of the application system; these log-in data consist of your user name (“Benutzerkennung”) and the password that you chose during the self-registration:

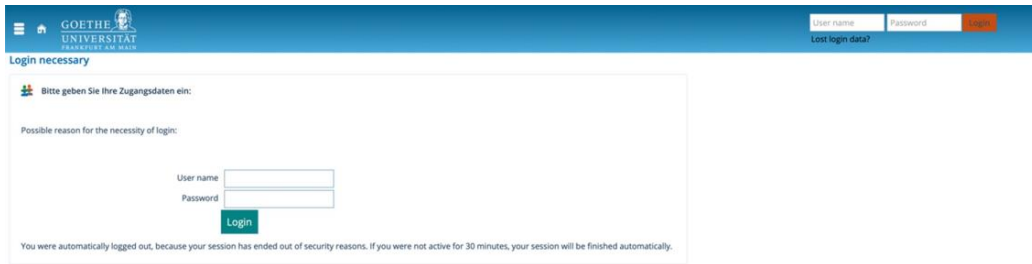

By clicking on “To overview”, you will be shown the application request that you have started. Entries and uploads of documents you have made prior to clicking on “To overview” will be saved. However, when continuing your application you will not be able to jump back to the point at which you

stopped working on the application, but must rather click through all sections that you already completed when clicking on “To overview”.

- You can proceed with your application by clicking “Continue to edit request”. Also, you will see the semester for which you are applying (all applications are for “Wintersemester”/“Winter Term”) and the final application deadline. In the upper right corner of the screen, you can see a number (here: “30”) that indicates how many minutes you have left in the current session. After time runs out you will be logged out automatically but may log in again at any time. The pre-set time limit is a security feature of the portal and will not make you lose entries you have already made, as your work on the application will be saved automatically.
- At any time during your work on the application, you may print a data control sheet that documents the information that you have already entered by clicking on “Print data control sheet [PDF]”.
- You may log out at any time. In that case, too, the information that you have already entered will be saved, and you may complete your application at any time prior to the final application deadline.

### Note for Uploading of Documents:

For the uploading of documents to the portal adhere to the following requirements:

- (1) Make sure to include the documents in PDF format.
- (2) Make sure to adhere to the specified **size limit**.
- (3) Make sure to name your documents in a **self-explanatory** way (for example: JustusJonas\_BachelorDegreeCertificate), with the document names consisting of **at least three letters**, excluding special symbols. Requirements for uploaded documents may be seen by clicking the circled “i”.

**Institute for Monetary and Financial Stability (IMFS)**

**Leibniz Institute for Financial Research SAFE**  
 SAFE offers funding for up to three excellent GSEFM candidates for the entire duration of the program, including a monthly grant in the first year and a student/research assistant position after successfully completing the qualifying examinations. The SAFE funding program is open to applicants for the Ph.D. Program in Finance as well as to candidates for the Ph.D. Program in Economics who pursue finance as one field in their studies. SAFE will give preference to female applicants in case of equal qualification.
